Retail - Risk Management Considerations

Whatever size of your business, your management responsibilities will include multi-disciplinary activities within the building itself and their impact upon people and the workplace. This includes responsibility for space management, building maintenance, administration and contract management.

These key considerations will help your business reduce risk in order to ensure the health and safety of anyone who works in/on, or visits the premises, including any associated vehicles used.

Key Considerations for Retail Businesses

1. Do you hold a valid Fire certificate for the premises?
2. Do staff know what to do if there is a fire and how to evacuate the premises safely?
3. Do you have "adequate and appropriate" First Aiders on site?
4. Is their training up to date including, if appropriate, the use of defibrillators?
5. What training are staff given on how to properly lift, handle and carry objects to avoid back and other injuries?
6. How do you ensure that any grounds or land around your property are safe: this includes access and egress points for those with a disability; pathways kept clear and well lit; a clear separation of pedestrians and vehicles (especially around delivery areas and in carparks)?
7. Are you aware of, and have a procedure in place that adheres to, the legal requirements for dealing with waste?
8. How to safely manage outside areas?
9. What are the legal requirements for the disposal of waste?
10. Have staff been briefed on how to handle violence and confrontation within the workspace?

The above examples are for illustration purposes only, particular risks being specific to business needs and insurance underwritten.
