## Precision Engineering - Risk Management Considerations

Regardless of company size or the activity undertaken, manufacturing processes in precision engineering carry the potential for injury to employees.

As a business that operates an engineering workshop creating your own products, or maintaining and repairing plant and machinery, using this guidance will enable you to identify the most important actions to take and how to enact them appropriately, and in accordance with the law.

These key considerations will help your business reduce risk in order to ensure the health and safety of anyone who works in/on, or visits the premises, including any associated vehicles used.

### Key Considerations for Precision Engineering

1. Have all statutory checks on machinery and equipment been carried out and are up to date? Have you completed PUWER inspections on powered machinery, including emergency stops and machinery guarding?
2. Noise is a major issue affecting staff health in production operations. What provision is made to monitor and control noise levels?
3. Do you hold a valid fire certificate for the premises? Do staff know what to do if there is a fire and how to evacuate the premises safely?
4. Does your workshop have adequate and appropriate ventilation for the type of work carried out there?
5. Are all water tanks / plumbing etc. professionally and regularly checked for Legionella contamination?
6. In any workshop things sometimes go wrong. What provision/procedures do you have in place to deal with these unplanned events?
